Steps to Develop a Priority Specific Implementation Plan

1. Identify priorities from the NCCP



2. Identify partners, stakeholders



- 3. Work with partners to develop an action plan
- Tasks
- Responsibility
- Stakeholders to engage
- Timeframe
- Resources (have/need)
- Measures to track progress



4. Take action:

- Priority working group leads
- Coordinate with stakeholders
- Ensure work is evidence based
- Consider current context/political support and adjust



5. Track and communicate progress






Identify Priorities (because you can't do it all at once)

Identifying priorities allows you to:

- Stay focused on outcomes: Prioritize at the NCCP objective level (measurable objective or goal)
- Be strategic about resources: Seek resources for what is most critical
- Engage partners: Partners are more likely to work on something specific, timebound, actionable
- Build in flexibility: Adapt to changes in evidence, technology, political support





Sample Criteria for Identifying Priorities

- Is this a significant area of need in our country?
- Does this effort have a reasonable chance for success?
- Do we have or will we be able to obtain resources to successfully implement the priority?
- What is the likelihood that we will be able to recruit other individuals and organizations to work on this over the few years?
- Will this add value to our country's cancer efforts?

- Build on existing programs and systems
- Track progress on the tasks needed to meet measurable outcomes – policy development, data collection, etc.
- Anticipate challenges in resources, partner involvement, political support, time it takes to complete tasks – and adjust plans as needed
