6.0 GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Introduction

Implementation of the NCCP will be overseen by a well-defined governance structure, to provide visibility, coordination, and guidance of cancer control activities across the country.

The main goal of governance will be to ensure that operations by all stakeholders are aimed at achieving the outcomes of the plan.

- Oversight - National Steering Committee under the PMO
- Coordination- National Cancer Control Secretariate with technical guidance of Uganda Cancer Institute under the MoH
- At the district activities will be overseen by the district health committee with cancer control focal person.
