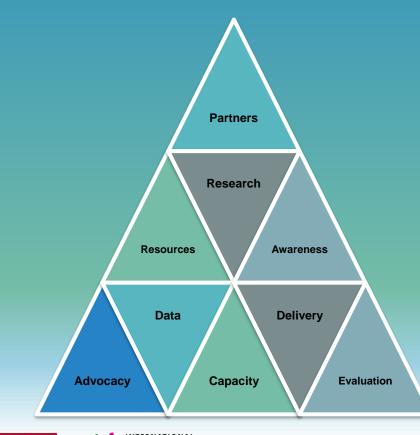

ICCP ECHO Purpose and Outcomes



- Increased knowledge about and awareness of NCCP implementation resources, tools
