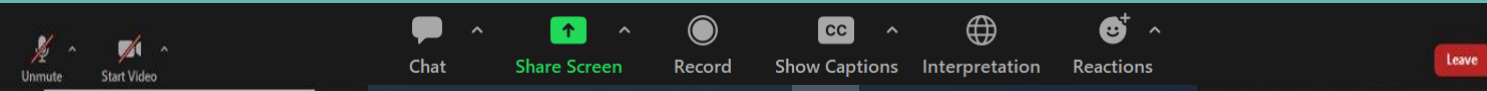

Fig. III.1. Process of cancer control planning, financing, implementing and monitoring.

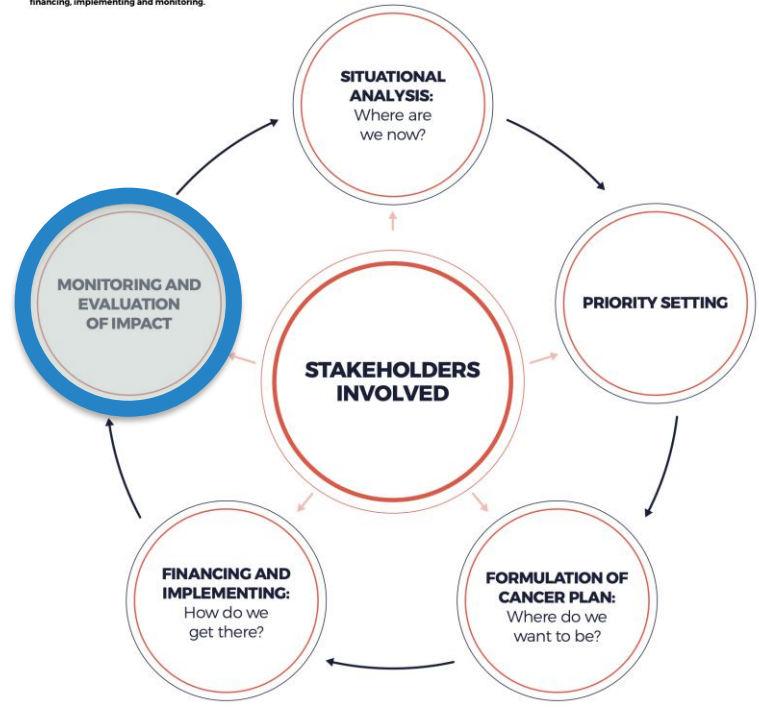
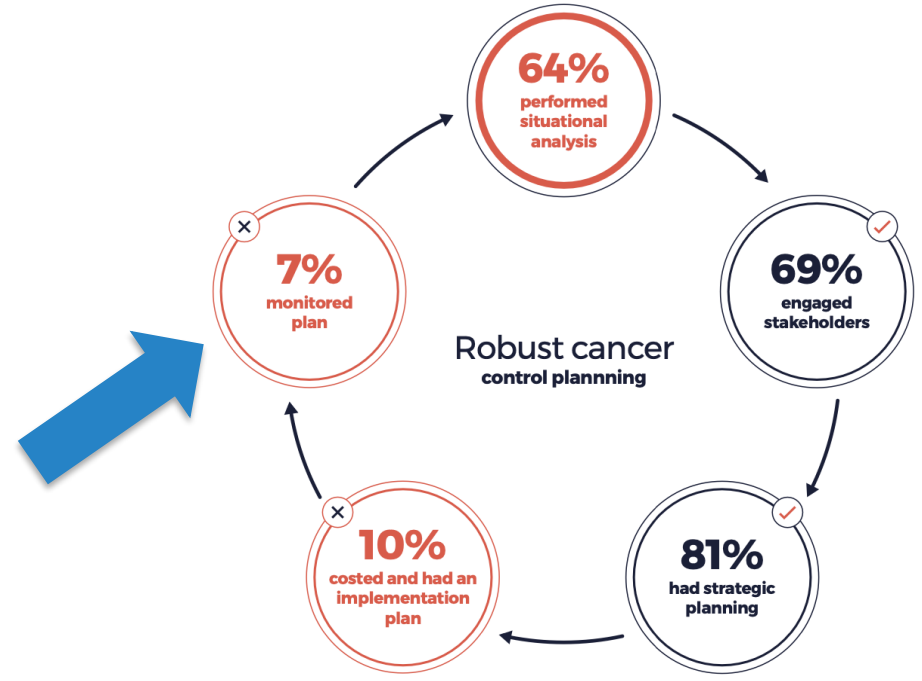


Fig. 6.1: Common gaps in cancer control plans and lack of evidence of implementation



# More Uses of Data for Cancer Control

- Monitoring progress
  - Vaccination data
  - Number of persons screened and outcomes
  - New policies
  - Tobacco sales/use
- Evaluating success of cancer control programs
  - Monitoring incidence
    - Increase or decrease
  - Monitoring mortality
    - Decrease
  - Monitoring stage at diagnosis
    - Toward earlier stage
