



# ICCP-ECHO

## Priority statement:

- Objective 2- To increase the number of facilities providing screening early detection and linkages to care to 60% from baseline

## Progress so far:

- A baseline assessment for screening was done
- Trained Health care workers on cancer screenings mainly cervical cancer
- Appointment of Regional cancer focal persons
- Community groups community based organisations, church, RHMs
- Refreshers, mentorship and Supportive supervision visits to sites
- Despite covid-19 we had cervical cancer campaigns country wide to increase screenings ( total 24)
- SOP's, JOB Aids, IEC and Speculum distribution

## Challenges:

- Private sector compliance and attendance
- Data capturing portal unstable (CMIS)
- Loss to follow up of referred clients to regional hospitals
- Nurse to client ratio overwhelming

## Tools and /or expertise needed:

- Human resource needed in facilities (nurses, patient navigators, doctors)
- Transport
