Increased capacity to understand and identify factors influencing NCCP implementation


A network of expertise and practice among countries

## NCCP Implementation Strategies



- Improving data collection and use of data for NCCP implementation
- National coordination of cancer control efforts and partners
- Importance of costing, financing, and allocating resources for NCCPs
- Resource mobilization and advocacy
- Mobilizing the healthcare workforce, capacity building
- Use of data for monitoring, evaluation, and research
- Improving service delivery, implementing system changes


